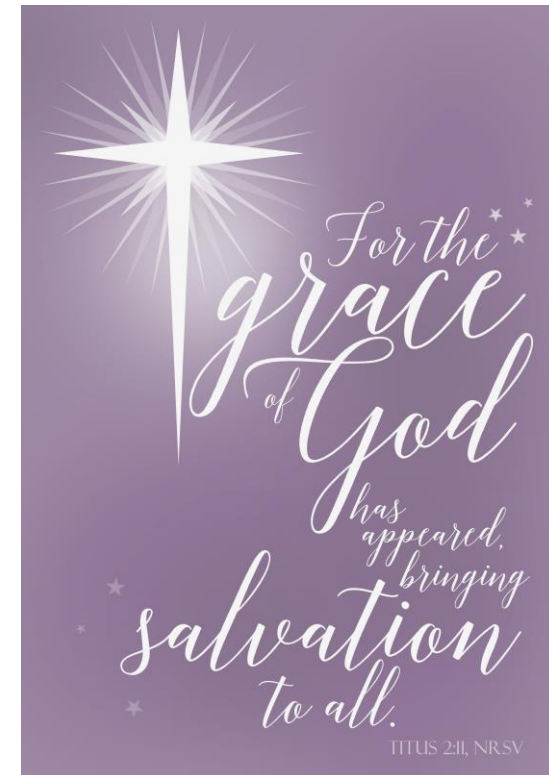
Avery Street Christian Reformed Church seeks to be a church that loves Jesus and loves our neighbors.
