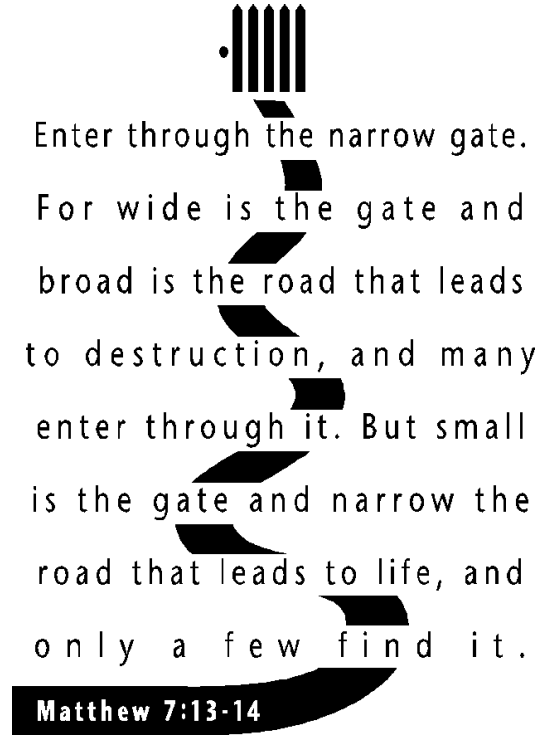
MISSION STATEMENT
